c. Trustee Report

Completed interviews and entire process for a new superintendent. Will be making the announcement as soon as everything is finalized. June 7-9 dates secured for

negotiations with Alberta Teacher Union. Bus driver liaison meeting is coming up to discuss any day to day concerns. Anything outside of their collective agreement. Supervisor curriculum meeting with how the curriculum is unfolding in our schools. We did hear a lot of positive feedback. Teachers have felt overwhelmed but grateful that the teachers have compassion and dedication to learning and teaching. Early learning coordinator. Completed 2023-2024 school calendar. Had good response to survey -over 1800. A second survey was sent out to staff -feedback around Christmas break. Was decided to end school later in December and return the second week of January. ASCA in person this year. HPSD pays for 2 members from each school council to attend and access to \$350 per school to cover extra expenses such as travel and accommodations. Still searching for bus drivers. Approved at last board meeting for Busy Bee Daycare to Lease the building in Routhier yard. Approved in full a national field trip for GPV and other schools in the division.

Karin and Lynn are attending the rural school board symposium this Sunday to Tuesday. An opportunity for people in similar situations, facing similar issues to discuss ideas. Busing -approached by a couple of concerned parents who are checking the app and finding it is not updated. Looking for feedback on what parents are using for Bus updates -ex -talking to bus driver or checking the app. Seems most parents are checking in with bus drivers. App is not up to date it seems in general. Does not seem to be a point in having an app that is not up to date.

Questions that have been brought forward:

-How are the minus 35 decisions made? Last week it was below minus 35 in most areas and buses ran. Who makes the decision and from where? Trustees will take back to meeting and bring back answers.

9. New Business

- a. ASCA Conference & AGM – April 21-23 Edmonton and Zoom -zoom may only be for the AGM and not the whole conference. Let us know if anyone is interested in attending, we can send 2 from each school.
- b. School Council Engagement Grant -How to Spend. We can spend \$500 from each school to find a way to get more people involved in school councils. If anyone has any ideas, please share. We have until June to spend it, but if we do not spend it the money goes back to the Government. If you bring a speaker can you buy food? Food/Snacks is more attractive for people. Information for parents around vaping is an idea. Wondering if the wellness coaches have any insight into what the kids are thinking about? Administration will reach out to wellness coaches for their ideas. General lack of mental health supports in our area. Idea -Wellness Night =vaping talk, anxiety talk, etc with snacks and then parents and students can access which they are interested in. Possible that vaping is a symptom of a broader concern -such as mental wellness that is lacking.

Will find out if the grant will cover snacks.

c. GPV Renovations – Update, nothing has been finalized but it seems it is very likely the renovation will happen. If the renovation does happen a large portion of the school will be lost. ‘School Right Sizing’. GPV has been on the list since 1997. The school will be smaller and the gym will be bigger. Losing the small gym and extending the big gym to fit 2 courts. However, main point is that this is not for sure yet. No secured funding yet. The idea of right sizing is to save on efficiency costs. Brainstorming about a sports academy idea. Add in 80 mins of sports per day. A huge benefit to the community to keep kids here. Would help to have community coaches who can volunteer. This year we have really seen the traditional model of schooling is not working for all students. Another brainstorming idea is looking for an outreach school outside of the west end of High Prairie. Post Covid still seeing a lot of learning gaps which is causing major disruption in the classroom. The path to graduation is not straight. Outreach = learning at your own pace and a teacher will support you. HP has this now. It is a different environment, more flexible, not as rigid. Students don’t have to be one or the other. Right now however, it is not feasible as closest place is HP. Loss of Alberta Distance Learning is being felt. Would be great if Alberta were to bring that back. Noted that Sask is now bringing it in.
